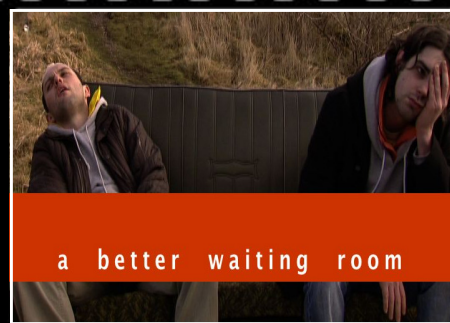
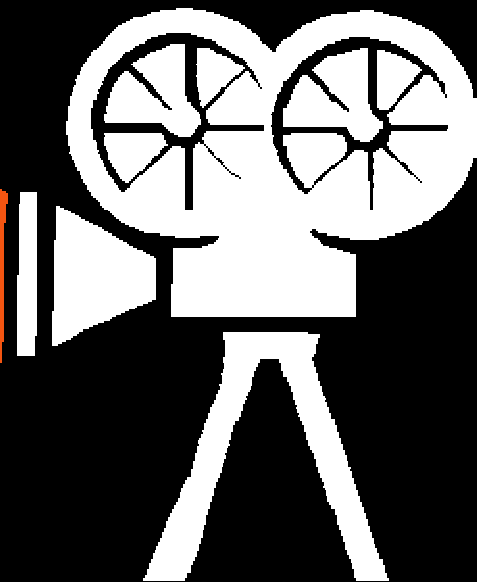


EPILEPSY: FILM NIGHT

On a summer break from college, Ivy, a young woman with epilepsy struggles to balance her feelings for her fledgling boyfriend while her friend Al crashes with her for the holidays in New York city. *The Exploding Girl* is an exquisite portrait of a young girl coming of age, earning Kazan the best actress award at the 2009 Tribeca Film Festival.

Short Films

Shaken (2009) by Sylvia Rincon (US). A dramatic, cultural exploration of the wider impact of epilepsy on family members. Commended short film, International League Against Epilepsy (ILAE) Centenary Award for Film.

A Better Waiting Room (2009) by Aled Smith (Wales). A black comedy that explores the ways in which epilepsy can on occasion, work to someone's advantage. Commended short film, ILAE Centenary Award for Film.

Ictal (2009) by Gus Cummins (England). Innovative short film depicting a seizure from the individual's own viewpoint. Overall winner, ILAE Centenary Award for Film.
